## **4<sup>th</sup> DOUBLE CAC /CACIB INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP DOG SHOW**

### **November 2016, Championship Dog Show (CAC / CACIB) – CRUFTS QUALIFIER 2017**

The Malta Kennel Club will be holding its next FCI CAC / CACIB Dog Show on Saturday and Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> / 20<sup>th</sup> November 2016, at the BMX Indoor Premises near Sir Adrian Dingli Street PEMBROKE. The Judges for this show are the International all breed judges Mr Stefan Sinko from Slovenia and Mr Nenad Davidovich from Serbia and Group judges Mrs Olga Sinko from Slovenia, and Mrs Natasa Davidovich from Serbia. Registrations for the show are open with 1<sup>st</sup> Closing date Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 and second closing date Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 at 8.00p.m. Registrations after the 2<sup>nd</sup> closing date closing date **WILL DEFINITELY NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

*The Registration Fees for the show are as follows:*

*All entries have to be paid on registration. If persons do not turn up at the show for whatever reason we regret no refunds will be given.*

***A show programme is given free with the first entry.***

***Members: - €15.00 per entry for the first three entries and €13.00 for subsequent entries. The registration fee for members for entries made on the last week (before 2<sup>nd</sup> Closing date) will be as follows:***

***Members: First three entries 17 euro per entry and-15.00 euro for subsequent entries including couple, group and veteran classes.***

***Non-Members (foreign Nationals): - €50.00 per entry for the first three entries for each day of show and €30.00 for each day of show for all other entries including couple, group and veteran classes.***

***(first 3entries -1 dog for 2 shows – Saturday and Sunday – fee is 100 euro) if registered before 1<sup>st</sup> Closing date.***

***The registration fee for members for entries made on the last week (before 2<sup>nd</sup> closing date) will be as follows:***

***Members: First three entries 17 euro per entry and-15.-00 euro for subsequent entries***

***The registration fee for non-members made in the last week (before 2<sup>nd</sup> closing date) will be as follows:***

***Non Members (Foreign Nationals) 55 euros for the first three entries and 35 euro for all other entries.***

*Foreign Nationals who handle dogs not entered by them / belonging to Maltese members the latter will pay a levy of €15.00. for each dog handled*

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1. PLEASE NOTE THAT ONLY A LIMITED NUMBER OF ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. A MAXIMUM 550 DOGS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS.
  2. ENTRY INSIDE THE RING WILL BE CARRIED OUT IN TAG NUMBER ORDER.
  3. PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE LATE FOR THEIR CLASS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED IN THE RING ONCE THE JUDGING HAS STARTED.
  4. ONCE PARTICIPANTS ARE IN THE RING AND JUDGING HAS STARTED CHANGING OF HANDLERS IS NOT ALLOWED. CHANGING OF HANDLERS IS ALSO NOT ALLOWED IN GROUPS AND FINALS.

**ALL AWARDS WILL BE WITHHELD IF ANY PARTICIPANT/S DO NOT TURN UP FOR GROUP JUDGING OR ANY JUDGING OF FINAL PLACINGS EXCEPT IF THE PERSON/S PRODUCE A FLIGHT TICKET WHICH COINCIDES WITH THE JUDGING TIME.**

The Show Regulations are being presented below and they apply to all persons who register an entry or enter as a spectator for the show.

The Malta Kennel Club brings to the attention of all participants and attendants to the Show that no merchandise or promotional material bearing the name or logo of any dog food is permitted in the Show venue itself but not in the show rings and as long as it is one of the Sponsors of the Malta Kennel Club during the current Show. Furthermore the promotion of Kennel names, Breeders or Handlers is not allowed in the the show rings and is being extended to the Show Hall.

- 1. All exhibitors and handlers must be fully paid up members of the Malta Kennel Club. Only foreign nationals residing abroad are allowed to exhibit or handle dogs without being fully paid up members subject that they have paid the appropriate entry fees.*
- 2. Foreign Nationals who handle dogs not entered by them / belonging to Maltese members will pay a levy of €15.00. for each dog handled*
- 3. It is a requirement that all exhibiting dogs are microchipped. The microchip number must be provided with the registration for the show. A dog which is found not microchipped will not be allowed to participate.*
- 4. Foreign owned dogs must be registered in an organisation recognized by the FCI. Breeds that are banned according to FCI and/or Maltese legislation cannot participate.*
- 5. Dogs entering the show venue must be vaccinated against distemper and parvo virus and foreign dogs must also include vaccination against rabies. Documentation for vaccination may be requested by show officials*
- 6. Dogs entering the show venue must be in good mental and physical health condition and not have signs of illness. Female dogs that show signs to be on heat cannot enter the show venue. If a dog carries a defect, the exhibitor must have a veterinary certificate available with him during the show venue. If the show officials require a show veterinarian, any treatment must be paid for by the exhibitor.*
- 7. Exhibitors or members of the public that bring dogs in the show venue are requested to be in control of their pets and are asked to be responsible for their actions and will have to meet expenses if their dogs cause damages in the venue or to third parties.*
- 8. The Malta Kennel Club brings to the attention of all participants and attendants to the Show that no merchandise or promotional material bearing the name or logo of any dog food is permitted in the Show venue itself unless it is one of the Sponsors of the Malta Kennel Club during the current Show. Furthermore the promotion of Kennel names, breeders or handlers is not allowed in the ring and the Show Hall.*
- 9. Members are reminded that the practice of double handling is not permitted in any Class. Anyone caught carrying out this practice will be penalized, may be asked to leave the show venue and any awards won will be forfeited.*
- 10. Junior handlers residing abroad can compete in the Junior Handler competition however points will only be awarded to the Maltese Junior Handlers who are eligible to represent Malta in Crufts / European / World Show. Junior members will have to produce their Birth Certificate with the entry for the show/s.*
- 11. A judge's written report on the exhibited dog will be available at the judge's discretion.*

12. *Participants are requested to maintain a high standard of cleanliness in the Hall and in the surrounding grounds and are requested to clean after their dogs. Cleaning equipment and bins for the disposal of litter will be provided. Any dog fur should be removed from the floor.*
13. *It is the responsibility of parents to make sure they have full control of their children at all times. Children must be supervised continuously by their parents and/or their guardian and should not be allowed to enter areas which are not allocated for the show venue. Bikes, skates and skateboards are not allowed in the venues. Any damages caused by children are to be borne by their parent/s, or guardians.*
14. *Exhibitors are reminded that they should wear attire fit to exhibit dogs in the show ring. For your guidance attire attributed to a 'smart casual' should be observed. Exhibitors should not be scantily dressed - low necked tops and mini skirts and shorts are not allowed in the ring.*
15. *Any members or the general public entering the show venue are reminded that support to exhibitors in the ring is restricted only to clapping. No shouting, whistling or any other noise is allowed in the main hall.*
16. *No person is permitted to bring alcohol in the Show Venue or its surrounding areas which are the responsibility of the Club during the event. Any person who consumes alcohol in the Show venue or has consumed alcohol in excessive quantity that disturbs other participants, judging, or the spectators or behaves in a manner not fit for the venue will be asked to leave and will be subject to disciplinary action.*
